

EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

The Board of Education, its officers and employees, shall not discriminate against any student, employee or applicant on the basis of actual or perceived race, ~~weight~~, national origin, ethnic group, creed, ~~religion~~, religious practice, gender, sexual orientation, age, marital/parental status, disability or predisposing genetic characteristic, military work or status, domestic violence victim status, or use of a guide dog, hearing dog or service dog, as applicable. While the board may expand upon their policies of nondiscrimination, state and federal statutes be mandated, and any further enactments would supersede this policy until such time as the appropriate policy revisions can be made.

The Board of Education, its officers and employees shall not discriminate against students on the basis of actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practice, disability, sex, sexual orientation or gender (including gender identity and expression).
