EQUAL OPPORTUNITY

The Board of Education, its officers and employees, shall not discriminate against any student, employee or applicant on the basis of actual or perceived race, weight, national origin, ethnic group, creed, religin, religious practicegender, sexual orientation, age, marital/parental status, disability or predisposing geneticharacteristic, military work or status, domestic violence victim status, or use of a guide dog, hearing dog or service dog, as applicative the board may expand upon their policies of ndiscrimination, state and federal statute mandated, and any further enactments would supersede this policy until such time as the appropriate policy revisions can be made.

The Board of Education, its officers and employees shall not discriminate against students on the basis of actual or perceived race, color, weight, national origin, ethnic group, religion, religious practice, disability, sex, sexual orientation or gender (including gendeitydemd expression).

This policy of nondiscrimination and non-
